Mobile App Load Instructions



Step 1 (locate the app)

From your mobile device:

- **Option 1:** Scan the QR code on this page, then go to Step 3.
- **Option 2:**
 - Visit www.careertapp.com,
 - locate the mobile app,
 - tap the icon to access the mobile app load page, then go to Step #2.
- **Option 3:** Go directly to the following link: <http://careertapp.com/mobile/msnnursing/>

Step 2 (load the app)

On the Mobile App Download Page, tap the "**Get This App**" button, then continue to Step 3.

Step 3 (save the app)

Once the app loads, follow the device-specific steps below to save the app to the home screen of your mobile device.

iPhone & iPad

1. Open the App in Safari on your iPhone or iPad
2. Tap the **Share** button (box with arrow) or **Plus (+)** button located at the bottom of the screen.
3. Tap the icon that says **Add to Home Screen**

Android

1. Open the App in Android's web browser
2. Use the menu to add a **Bookmark** for the App
3. View the bookmark in the bookmarks area
4. Select the **Add Shortcut to Home** option

BlackBerry

1. Open the App in BlackBerry's web browser
2. Press the "BlackBerry" key to bring up the pop-up menu.
3. Select **Add to Home Screen**
